



- Diamond Complex for regular season, regional tournaments, clinics, camps (Purcell recreation and economic benefit)  
4 Baseball and 4 Softball Fields  
T-ball/Machine pitch through high school baseball leagues with portable mounds and fencing inserts; Women, Co-ed and Adult softball
- Soccer Fields (3-4 full-size fields, adaptable for all ages)  
Fields can be used for Football (Youth tackle, Flag, Frisbee), Kickball for scheduled games and practice areas
- Skateboard/BMX park for all ages
- Our Purcell Golf Course that is moderate quality, capable of attracting day golfers and tournaments from the OKC metro region
- Frisbee Golf
- Climate controlled coliseum that will provide a venue for large scale (650-1,000 attendance) agricultural, equine, sports, convention, music events



## Leisure

- Parks facilities as regional draws and enjoyment by all Purcell citizens
- Red Hill  
300 seat Purcell Red Hill Heights Crystal Lookout with glass walls and services for event rental (banquet, wedding, corporate meetings, etc.) overlooking Canadian Valley and Sooner Country. For community events, visitor attraction, and conventions; walking trails; picnic tables; gardens; bird sanctuary for watching tourists; butterfly gardens for tourist attraction, trail and flowers
- An aquatic center that provides a regional draw with major slide features.
- Tennis Courts Complex (6) for all ages and tournament quality. Seating.
- Legacy features of statuary and art, gifted in memorial
- Miniature golf
- Frisbee golf
- Parks facilities for neighborhoods  
Neighborhood Pocket Parks with grass play area. Playground equipment. Basketball courts. Picnic tables.
- Splash pad
- Fenced dog-park for exercising pets
- Sand volleyball court(s)
- RV parking that will provide for short-term stays by visitors who come for vacations, special events and general travel. Located with reasonable access to I-35.
